Canby Art Park Sponsorship Levels

The 9,300 square foot lot located at the corner of Territorial Road and Holly Street is being preserved as a community Greenspace that celebrates our agricultural, historical, and river-based heritage, as well as our cultural diversity through elements of public art. All creative representation within the park will be in the form of native plants, indigenous animals and authenticated historical features. A dahlia might be planted in the space or it could be depicted through art. Indigenous animals could be those that historically were a part of our local heritage, such as deer or bear, or those that currently live in the area like beavers and squirrels. Historical features may include elements such as the Canby Ferry or early settlers.

The High Plateau Section (\$30,400 Total Sponsorship)

This section includes plateau mound and the bench and fountain on Territorial Road.

- \$ 2,500 Bench on High Plateau
- \$ 2,000 Ornamental Grass Covering for Plateau

The Canby History & Depot Section (\$26,400 Total Sponsorship)

This section includes the vegetation corner coming off the kiosk, rounds the entrance and includes the basalt columns behind the "Welcome to Canby" sign. This section borders The High Plateau and ends at the bench on Territorial.

The Community Circle Section (\$25,200 Total Sponsorship)

This section is from edge of drinking fountain, rounding Community Wall to the beginning of river boardwalk.

The Riverfront Section (\$23,500 Total Sponsorship)

This section is the Trex decking and the section of vegetation with the 3 trees up to the entrance leading into the neighborhood.

The Farm Section (\$20,500 Total Sponsorship)

This is the colored concrete area across from the Trex decking that is The Riverfront section.

This is the section coming off The Farm and The High Plateau area. This area also has vegetation on the border of The Farm and includes the single bench. The History/Depot area also borders this section facing Holly Street.
